

CITY OF HARRINGTON RESOLUTION NO.2015-198

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HARRINGTON, WASHINGTON, INCLUDING THE 2015 UPDATE IN THE HARRINGTON 2000+ PLAN.

WHEREAS, in 1997, the City of Harrington, with financial assistance from the Washington State Department of Community, Trade, and Economic Development, prepared the *Harrington 2000+ Plan: A Plan to Redevelop the Central Business District*; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Harrington Historic Preservation Commission received a grant from the Lincoln County Rural Development Fund to update the *Harrington 2000+ Plan*; and

WHEREAS, the Harrington Historical Preservation Commission, with the assistance of a consultant, held a series of public workshops and meetings attended by local residents, business owners, property owners, and other stakeholders for the purpose of updating the *Harrington 2000+ Plan*; and

WHEREAS, based upon the input received at these public workshops and meetings, an update to the *Harrington 2000+ Plan* was prepared, recommending a number of steps that the City of Harrington and its citizens can take to further redevelop the Central Business District;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRINGTON, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

Section 1. The 2015 Update to the *Harrington 2000+ Plan*, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth, shall be included as part of the existing 1997 *Harrington 2000+ Plan: A Plan to Redevelop the Central Business District*.


Section 2. The Goals and Actions set forth in the updated *Harrington 2000+ Plan* will serve as proposed guidelines and suggested actions to define and advance the Harrington Historic Central Business District.

Section 3. Any development or redevelopment of the Harrington Historic Central Business District shall be governed by the rules, regulations, resolutions and ordinances now in existence or hereafter duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Harrington.


