

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE KEEPING OF DAIRY COWS, AND ALL OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND FOWLS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF HARRINGTON, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES CREATED BY THE KEEPING OF SAID ANIMALS AND POULTRY.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Harrington, Lincoln County, State of Washington, as follows to-wit:

Section 1. That from and after the passage and approval of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, to keep or bring a cow or cows, horses, mules, cattle, swine, sheep, goats or any other live stock into the town without first obtaining a permit from the Town Clerk of said town, by making application to said clerk which shall be approved or rejected by the town council.

Section 2. That after said person, persons, firm or corporation shall have obtained a permit to keep a cow, cows, horses, mules, cattle, swine, sheep, goats, or any other live stock within the said town, it shall be unlawful for them to allow the barn, shed, yard, grounds or premises to become, from any cause, nauseous, foul, offensive or injurious to health; that the said owners of said cow, cows, horses, mules, cattle, swine, sheep, goats, or any other live stock shall keep the premises in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall remove all offal at least once a week.

Section 3. That from and after the passage and approval of this ordinance, that it shall be unlawful for any horses, mules, cow or cows, swine, sheep, goats, or any other stock, or fowls such as chickens, geese, ducks, or turkeys, to run or go at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Harrington.

Section 4. That after the passage of this ordinance the Town Council of the town of Harrington, shall have absolute control over all of the conditions mentioned in this ordinance with full power to abate any such nuisances as provided by law.

Section 5. That any person, persons, firm or corporation deemed to be guilty of violating this ordinance or any part of said ordinance, a complaint shall be filed in writing with the police justice court in the Town of Harrington, and against the person or persons charged with the violation of this ordinance and after a hearing of said complaint the defendant or defendants are found guilty they will be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not to exceed \$100.00 and the court shall order said nuisance to be removed at the expense of said person or persons creating or maintaining the same.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after five days after its passage and publication.
