Minutes
August 21, 2018

The August Public Development Authority meeting was called to order at 7:05pm on August 21, 2018 by President Heather Slack. Those present were Heather and Bunny. Harvest jobs kept the attendance low.

The minutes were reviewed and a correction noted in the spelling of "Slack"

The treasurer's report showed a balance of \$846.95.

The following items were discussed:

- 1) There was a problem getting the pinewood derby track out of the basement at City Hall. Scott McGowan indicated he and the City crew would make another effort to remove it.
- 2) Fall Festival sign went up on the highway sign board.
- 3) The face book page has been completed.
- 5) A proposed "Did you know" sign was explained. The sign would list positive things about the community that visitors or even local residents would find interesting and informative. The sign could be put in the window at the Carrot Patch building or at the Historic Preservation head -quarters on Third Street.
- 6) Tim Tipton has applied for another grant for the vacant lot at Third and Willis. Tim will participate in the September 17th "feed -back" session to go over the Empire Health grant that we did not receive and hopefully learn about where we could improve in writing future grants.
- 7) A sign at the vacant lot with a copy of the drawing of the plans for the green space on Third Street was discussed. It would be nice to have something in place by the Fall Festival. It was doubtful that a commercial sign could be ready for the Sept. 22nd date, but perhaps a laminated copy of the drawing could be displayed at the site of the project.
