 - b. Nathan would like to learn to repoint brick so he can help repair the wall where the sign exists, and possibly the town square remanent wall.
 - c. Memorial Hall facade improvement project for 2020 - this will be moved to next spring
 - d. Design review document (Karen) - this was tabled for the next meeting
 - e. The Town Square project was discussed and Tim will get the vintage fire truck set up in the square for the car show, along with a sign to get attention, and a table with information for people to take with them. The Town Square video will run in the art room during the car show. To ramp up the fund raising, it was brought up that perhaps a summer bbq in the Town Square lot would bring people together. Another idea was a photo contest. Nathan Luck will had out maps to car show participants. Ideas were brought forth about expanding the car show to have more events of interest to the car show participants.
